8 1/2 inch square unfinished 8 inch square finished

FABRICS:

One fall leaf print of your choice. It can be blueish green, brown, gold, green, purple, red, yellow, etc. One solid brown and one solid teal.

Cutting:

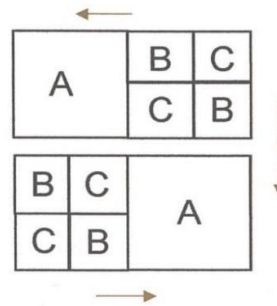
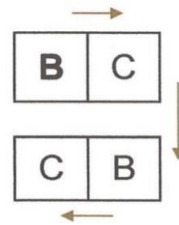
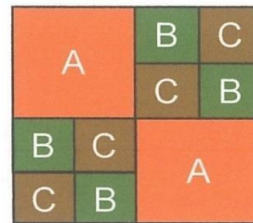
- 2 4 1/2 inch squares from the leaf print for letter A
- 4 2 1/2 inch squares from solid teal for letter B
- 4 2 1/2 inch squares from solid brown for letter C

Sewing:

Across, sew the letters B to the letters C and the letters C to the letters B and press the seams according to the arrows. Sew the top units to the bottom units to make two 4-patch units and press the seams according to the arrows. Sew letter A to one 4-patch unit and press toward the leaf print and do the same with the other letter A and 4-patch. Sew the top unit to the bottom unit and press according to the arrow.

Suggestion:

This quilt block along with other quilt blocks of this month would make a wonderful autumn wall hanging or table runner.



Anne Marie's Scrap Tip

Ironing involves moving the iron across the fabric to smooth out wrinkles. When pressing, you lift the iron up and set it down again in a new area. Pressing is preferred for quilt blocks and quilt tops to prevent distorting them.
