Bring the following:

Sewing machine or Serger machine
Sewing supplies, thread
Extension cord
Threader/bobbin for the dresses
Fabric marker for labels for dress size

What we need donated for sewing projects:

Fabric: Children fabric for pillowcases and fabric for dresses. We need width of fabric and lengths of 22" to 31" for the dresses or Pillowcase for making a dress.

1 Ironing board and no irons as using ones BVQ owns.
cutting mats and rotary cutters and rulers
Rick Rack and lace and fancy edging for dress
Extra fabric for pockets and buttons
Double Fold Bias Tape – 2 ½ yards per dress
¼" elastic – 12" to 16" used per dress

FOOD

Salad and dressings (2/3 people)
A dessert (2 people)
Drinks - Ice Tea, diet drink, water
Ice
