

# Brandywine Valley Quilters

## Guild Challenge 2019 – August 13, 2019



The Challenge for August is to create a charity quilt to be donated to the NCIU at a Children's Hospital. It is to be used to cover the incubator of a preemie baby to block the bright lights. The preemie baby will then take the quilt home with them when he/she leaves the hospital.

### Guidelines:

- The quilt should measure 25x25, 30x30, or 36x 36 inches square. The top should be pieced and the binding can be done blanket style. Fabric suitable for children is preferred.
- All fabric must be cotton; no metallic fabric or embellishments.
- Cotton batting.
- The back should be a solid piece of fabric (cotton or flannel)
- DO NOT use monofilament thread or tie the quilt. No rag quilts.
- We will not be judging these quilts; for each quilt that you enter, you will receive a chance at a gift card.
- Quilts may be turned in at any time from now until August.

**Our Goal is 100 preemie quilts!**
